What is a Flood Control Lake?

There are five large flood-control lakes in Lancaster County. Four flood control lakes protect the City of Lancaster and one protects the Town of Kershaw.

These lakes are overseen by Watershed Boards of Directors, which are dedicated groups of volunteers that protect Lancaster County citizens from flood damages.



What is a Watershed Director?

The Cane Creek Watershed Board of Directors oversees the four lakes which protect Lancaster, and the Little Lynches Watershed Board of Directors oversees the one which protects Kershaw.

The Directors volunteer their time to inspect the flood control lake dams/ spillways and ensure maintenance work is done to keep the dams in good shape. The Directors are elected officials and the position is non-partisan. They serve because they are concerned about their communities and fellow citizens. There are five directors on each Watershed Board. Directors must live in

the watershed district they serve.
